

ST PETERS PANDEMIC RESPONSE PLAN - DELTA

(Please note, this plan is ultimately determined by Government Regulations & Responses throughout the ongoing crisis)

GREEN: NATIONAL LEVEL ONE

- Practice regular hand washing.
- Encourage people to sanitise/wash their hands upon entering the facilities.
- Cough or sneeze into tissue or elbow.
- Multiple services, plus live stream, sick people asked to join us remotely
- Youth, Courses and Small groups may meet, sick people asked to stay away.
- Food and drink safely offered.
- Contact tracing code displayed, encouraged use of sign-in by all people entering the premises.

YELLOW: NATIONAL LEVEL TWO (DELTA)

- Church office open for staff and contractors only.
- No hire of facility to external groups.
- Kitchen is closed (except for Community Lunch preparation Tuesday).
- SPH Courses continued under strict guidelines
- Staff to stay home if sick. Cough or sneeze into tissue or elbow.
- *Mask wearing compulsory.* Social distancing observed as per Government regulations.
- All visitors/staff to sign-in or use QR code
- Practice regular hand washing. Regular surface cleaning.
- Ensure all people sanitise/wash their hands upon entering the facilities.
- Youth, Courses and Small groups meet via Zoom or other Social Media platform.
- Tuesday Community Lunches via Cameron Rd Entrance – boxed takeaway lunch
 - No hugs, handshakes, hand holding, cheek kissing or hongis.
 - 2 Metre Social distancing, provide sanitisers.
 - Volunteers to wear masks when serving food and practice hygiene in preparation.
- Sunday Services uploaded to YouTube – no services held on premises. Zoom 'Break-out Rooms' after service
- Video messages on website, (*posting written sermons to those without internet when available*).
- Extra building cleaning measures in place.
- Pastoral care groups action plan starts. Phone calls to elderly and regular contact maintained to church members.

RED: NATIONAL LEVEL THREE and FOUR

- Church Building shut.
- Church office shut, all staff working from home.
- No Community Lunches
- Youth, Courses and Small groups to meet online.
- Support people who may need special care. Prayer and care shepherds actively calling those who have needs.
- Online church initiated, video messages on website, posting sermons to those without internet.
